The discount for the second and each additional dog can only be applied if the pedigree name matches the 1st entry. Any further changes on the second entry, such as adding co-ownership, will be considered as a new entry at full price. When exhibiting multiple dogs, an entry in the baby, puppy, or veteran class cannot be considered as the 1st entry.

The dogshow fee includes admission for one person for each entered dog and an dogshow catalog for the first dog.

The dogshow fee can be paid:

As the variable symbol, please provide the registration number of the first dog in the dog pedigree certificate (ČLP, N.H.S.B., FCPR,... - numeric format only).

As the specific symbol, please provide the number 13092024.

The fee is refunded only if the entry is rejected. If the registered dog is withdrawn, the fee is non-refundable. In the event that the dogshow is canceled due to force majeure (veterinary measures, natural disasters, etc.), the fees will be used to cover the costs associated with the dogshow. The date of submission of the application determines the differentiation of payments for the first and second deadlines.

DOGSHOW CONDITIONS

The dogshow is held according to the valid dogshow regulations of the Czech Kennel Club (ČMKU) and these propositions. The dogshow is open to male and female Český Fouseks registered in FCI-recognized studbooks who have reached the age required for inclusion in the class on the day of the dogshow. The dogshow organizer is not responsible for any damages caused by the dog or exhibitor, nor for the death or loss of the dog. Free roaming of dogs at the dogshow is not allowed.

By sending the application, the exhibitor agrees to the publication of personal data in the catalog.

Any incorrect classification of the exhibited individual into a ring or class must be addressed by the exhibitor with the dogshow secretary at the dogshow office before the start of judging in the ring.

To avoid any discrepancies in the catalog entry due to poor readability or incomplete completion of the application, **it is necessary to attach a double-sided photocopy of the pedigree of the registered dog to the application.**

Acceptance of the dog for the dogshow will be confirmed in writing by an entry card before the dogshow.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE DOGSHOW

- 1) Valid original pedigree certificate of the dog or attachment to the pedigree certificate
- 2) Vaccination certificate or passport for small animals – see veterinary conditions
- 3) Confirmation of the dog's acceptance for the dogshow (each exhibitor will receive an entry card after the processing of the dogshow catalog before the dogshow takes place).

EXCLUSION FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE DOGSHOW

- a) Dogs not listed in the catalog. An exception is made for dogs not clearly listed in the catalog due to the organizer's fault.
- b) Sick dogs, suspected of illness, post-injury, bitches in the second half of pregnancy, nursing bitches, and bitches in heat.

- c) Dogs owned by individuals whose right to exhibit has been revoked.
- d) Dangerous dogs - aggressive or biting towards people and other dogs.

PROTEST

Protest against the decision of the judge (awarding, placing, and titles) is not permissible.

Protest for formal reasons (violation of dogshow regulations or propositions) is permissible; it must be submitted in writing along with the payment of a security deposit of 1000 CZK. If the protest is not upheld, the security deposit is forfeited in favor of the dogshow organizer.

The protest must be submitted during the dogshow – no later than the end of judging.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS

Dogs participating in the dogshow must be clinically healthy and accompanied by a **vaccination certificate** or **passport for small animals** with valid rabies vaccination, **ensuring the dog's immunity**.

CLASSES

The division into classes is governed by the Dogshow Regulations of the Czech Kennel Club (ČMKU) and FCI and is indicated on the entry form.

At the dogshow, dogs are judged separately according to the breed coloration – see Breed Standard:

- White
- Brown

in the following classes:

- Baby class - age 4 – 6 months
- Puppy class - age 6 – 9 months
- Junior class - age 9 – 18 months
- Intermediate class - age 15 – 24 months
- Open class - from 15 months for all dogs regardless of completed tests and awards received
- Working class - from 15 months; accessible to dogs with a working certificate issued by the Stud Book.
- champion class - from 15 months; accessible to dogs with an acknowledged international or national champion title, National Winner title, Club Winner title, Special Dogshow Winner, European Winner, World Winner. The mentioned titles must be achieved in adult competition.
- veteran class - for dogs over 8 years old

The **age of the dog on the day of the dogshow** is decisive for classification, and other conditions must be met on the day of application. For inclusion in the working class, it is necessary to attach a **certificate of completed test** to the application (issued by ČMKJ, Lešanská 1176/2a, 141 00 Prague 4 for hunting breeds), and for inclusion in the

champion class, a **certificate of the awarded title**. If the application is not accompanied by these documents, **the organizer is obliged to place the dog in the open class**.

An individual disqualified at the dogshow cannot be judged.

TITLES AND AWARDS

Special Dogshow Winner Male/Female (awarded to the best male and best female in the competition of V1 CAC from the intermediate, open, working, and champion classes).

Special Dogshow Junior Winner Male/Female (awarded to the best male and best female in the competition of V1 CAJC from the junior class).

Special Dogshow Winner Veteran Male/Female (awarded to the best male and best female in the competition of Excellent 1 from the veteran class)

CAJC, CAC, Res. CAC, BOJ, BOV, BOS, BOB.

Awarding the title of Special Dogshow Winner/Special Dogshow Junior Winner is not conditioned by the owner's membership in the Czech Cesky Fousek Breeding Club (KCHČF, z.s.).

Competitions:

- **Best Breeding Group** - for at least 3 individuals of the same breed, judged at the dogshow, originating from one breeder and from at least two different sires or dams.
- **Most Beautiful Pair** - for a female and male of the same breed owned by one owner or co-owner (co-ownership must be proven by entry in the Pedigree), judged at the dogshow.
- **Young Exhibitor - Junior Handling - age groups: I. 9-13 years, II. 14-17 years.** The competition is with a dog registered in one of the Stud Books of FCI member countries, and it does not have to be judged at the dogshow. The presentation of the dog

is evaluated, and its quality is not important. Competition conditions are published in cynological magazines.

Registration for the Young Exhibitor competition is possible during the dogshow until the judging of males and females in the rings is completed. Participation in the competition is only allowed with a male/female judged at this dogshow.
